I. NAME

The name of the organization association will shall be known as Antique Engine \& Tractor Association Incorporated.

## II. PURPOSE

A. To promote the collection, restoration, preservation and exhibition of gasoline and oil engines, gasoline and steam tractors, power driven farm machinery and other equipment of historical value as an agricultural, educational and historical society.
B. To promote wholesome recreation and to cooperate with other social agencies for the promoting community improvement, education and to encourage preservation of all types of agriculturally related antiques and artifacts.

## III. MEMBERSHIP Classes and dues

Family membership will include head of household, spouse and children under18 years of age.
Individual membership will include members 16 years of age to 74 years of age.
Senior membership will include members age 75 and older after September 20, 2021.
Lifetime members will include members 75 and older on or before September 20, 2021.
Dues for each membership class will be published annually and reviewed/adjusted by the board as needed.
A. Membership dues shall be reviewed and adjusted by the board as needed.

Membership will include head of household, spouse and children under 18. Members are allowed 1 (one) vote per membership. eard.
B. All eard holding members $\mathbf{1 6}$ years and over may vote.
C. A member will have life membership after 75 years of age.
IV.v. OFFICERS AND COMMITTEES

Officers shall witl ${ }_{\text {wonsist }}$ of: President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer.
The officers will be elected annually by the Board of Directors.
C. Committees shall will be appointed by the president or presiding officer Officers and may consist of any member. or interested individuals.
D. There shall will be an executive committee, with executive powers only, which-shalt consist consisting of the officers of the corporation association.
V.vi. $^{\text {AMENDMENTS }}$
A. An amendment to this constitution may be introduced at any time, but must require a $2 / 3$ majority vote of the members present.
V..IV. DIRECTORS

A, A Board of Directors shal ${ }_{\text {board of directors will }}$ consist of ${ }_{\text {nine (9) }} \boldsymbol{9}$ (nine) $\boldsymbol{D}_{\text {directors. }}$ The ${ }_{d} \mathbf{D i}$ rectors shall will each serve staggered terms consisting of $\mathbf{3}$ (three) three (3) years. The Officers shall ${ }_{\text {with }}$ be elected annually by the Board of Directors. (Move to IV. B) The president should serve at least $\mathbf{1}$ (one) one (1) year as adirector before being elected to office.
c. Director vacancies within a normal three (3) year term will be filled by an association member appointed by the board to complete the term.
D. The retiring ${ }_{\mathrm{p}}$ President, if not seeking reelection to the ${ }_{\mathrm{b}}$ Board of ${ }_{\mathrm{d}}$ Directors, shall will serve as an ex-officio non-voting member of the board for a period of one ${ }_{(1)}$ year following his/ her term expiration.

## BY LAWS

## I. RULES OF ORDER

"Roberts Rules of Order" shal will be the authority on all rules of procedure not specifically stated in the constitution and by-laws.

## II. DUTIES AND TERMS OF OFFICERS

A. Directors shall will be elected at the annual meeting.
B. In case of an officer vacancy vacancy of office, it shall will $^{\text {be filled by the an appointment election }}$ of from the ${ }_{b}$ Board of ${ }_{d}$ Directors.
C. The President shal ${ }_{\text {will }}$ preside at all meetings of the members and of the ${ }_{b}$ Board of directors.
D. The ${ }_{\mathrm{V}}$ Vice-p $\mathrm{P}^{2}$ President shall ${ }_{\text {will }}$ assume all duties of the ${ }_{\mathrm{p}}$ President upon the absence or resignation of the ${ }_{\mathrm{p}}$ President.
E. The secretary shall will keep a record of all meetings of the corporation and the ${ }_{\text {e Executive }}$ committee, and shall will prepare and keep a file of all members and committees.
F. The ${ }_{\text {t }}$ Treasurer shall ${ }_{\text {will }}$ sign all checks, vouchers and orders for payment as authorized. $\mathrm{He}_{\text {/she }}$ shall will have charge of all funds of the corporation and shall will deposit them in a bank or shal disperse them as authorized by the other ${ }_{0} \theta$ fficers. The ${ }_{\mathrm{p}}$ President and ${ }_{s}$ Secretary shall will also be authorized to sign checks when ${ }_{\text {as }}$ needed.
G. A membership chairman will be elected by the board with duties to maintain an accurate membership roster of the total membership and categorized by family, individual, life and senior memberships. He/she will reconcile membership dues with the treasurer so all dues are recorded and
н. G. The board shal will have the authority to hire an outside accounting firm as needed.

## III. MEETINGS

A. General membership meetings shall may be called by the $\mathbf{P}_{\mathrm{P}}$ resident on approximately a monthly basis.
B. Special meetings shall ${ }_{\text {will }}$ be held at any time at by the written request of $10 \%$ of the paid membership.
C. Board meetings shall will be called by the ${ }_{\mathrm{p}}$ President on approximately a monthly basis.
D. Failure to hold a general membership meeting will not constitute a forfeiture or dissolution of the corporation.
IV. QUORUM

A quorum for all meetings of the officers shal will consist of a majority of the $\boldsymbol{\theta}_{0}$ fficers ${ }_{\text {elected officers }}$ in charge.
B. A quorum for meetings of all committees shall will consist of a majority of the committee members.
C. A quorum for the ${ }_{b}$ Board of ${ }_{d}$ Directors shall ${ }_{\text {will }}$ consist of a majority of the ${ }_{d}$ Directors.
V. PAYMENTS OF CLAIMS AND AUTHORIZING OF WORK
A. All expenditures $\boldsymbol{\theta} \boldsymbol{f}_{\text {from }}$ all committees or individuals must be approved by the majority of the ${ }_{\text {board of directors }}$ efficers before any material or labor is contracted for.

## VI. REMOVAL OF OFFICERS

Any officer or ${ }_{d}$ Director may be removed for a cause at any time.
Any of the following may be an acceptable cause, such as gross lack of attendance at board meetings, meaning more than 3 consecutive ${ }_{\text {board }}$ meetings without notifying one a member of the $e_{e}$ Executive ${ }_{b}$ Board Members ${ }_{\text {and }}$ or failure to follow through with general responsibilities. may result in removal from the board by at least a $2 / 3$ board vote.
Removal from the board requires a $2 / 3$ majority vote of the board members.

## VII. RULES GOVERNING SHOW

The ${ }_{0}$ Officers shal ${ }_{\text {will, }}$ from time to time, make necessary rules concerning the show, exhibits and displays.
VIII. EMERGENCIES

By a 2/3 majority vote, The ${ }_{0}$ Officers may waive the rules and vote to pay for any claims against the Corporation.
IX. DISPLAY AREAS

All displays of running engines and other operating displays shall will be roped off at a safe distance. No person ${ }_{(s)}$ other than the owner ${ }_{(s)}$ or operator ${ }_{(s)}$ shall ${ }_{\text {will }}$ be permitted in this area ${ }_{\text {dis- }}$ play areas without the explicit permission of the said owner ${ }_{(s)}$ or operator ${ }_{(s)}$.

## X. NOMINATING COMMITTEE

It shall will be the duty of the ${ }_{b}$ Board of ${ }_{d}$ Directors of the Antique Engine and Tractor Association to appoint three (3) current members of the association to serve on the ${ }_{n}$ Nominating $c$ Committee. No member of the ${ }_{b}$ Board of ${ }_{d}$ Directors may serve on the ${ }_{n}$ Nominating ${ }_{c}$ Committee with the exception that a retiring board member not seeking
reelection may be appointed to the ${ }_{n}$ Nominating committee. It shall will be the duty of the ${ }_{n}$ Nominating Committee to select one $_{(1) \text { or more }}$ candidate $_{(s)}$ for each board position to be filled by the election $\boldsymbol{\theta f}{ }_{\text {for }}$ the ${ }_{b}$ Board of ${ }_{d}$ Directors at the December membership meeting.

## XI. ADDITIONAL NOMINATIONS

Any fifteen ${ }^{15}$ ) or more members acting together may make nominations by petition and the ${ }_{s}$ Secretary shall post such nominations at the same place where the list of nominations made by the ${ }_{n}$ Nominating ${ }_{c}$ Committee is posted. Nominations made by petition must be received by the ${ }_{s}$ Secretary of the ${ }_{b}$ Board of ${ }_{\mathrm{d}}$ irectors at least ${ }_{\text {thirty }}^{(30)}$ forty-five (45) calendar days prior to the date of the annual December membership meeting. held in December .

## XII. ELECTIONS

If no nominating petitions are received before the due date, a voice vote or standing vote of the membership to elect the members selected by the Nominating Committee will complete the election with the current Secretary casting one vote for the slate as submitted by the Nominating Committee.

If one or more nominating petitions are received with the required number of member signatures and within the required time frame then a paper ballot will be prepared prior to the annual meeting. The ballot will indicate the selections of the Nominating Committee and those that have submitted petitions. Each member of the club present at the annual meeting will be given one ballot at the annual meeting in order to make their selections. Each ballot marked with three or fewer selections will be tabulated by the current Secretary and the results read to the membership by the current President.

Federal or state mandates preventing in person meetings.

If there is only one (1) candidate for each open board position then the President or presiding officer may declare the election by acclamation.
If there is greater than one (1) candidate for each open board position, an official ballot will be mailed to each member by USPS or e-mail with a 10-day response period. Ballots will be returned to the Secretary for verification and compilation. The results will be provided to the board of directors.
In the event that there is a tie vote among two candidates, the president will cast the last and final vote to break the tie.
